



Tēnā koutou e aku rangatira,

This letter tells you how to pre-register for our online AGM.

We are delighted that more than 300 owners have already updated their email address so that they can pre-register quickly – kei te miharo atu!

We appreciate your support and patience as we enter into our first online AGM. While we would prefer a kanohi ki te kanohi meeting, the health of our whānau comes first (not to mention the speed of the Government possibly changing levels again) – me tiakina ō tātou kaumātua!

We understand that some whānau may have difficulty connecting to the AGM. We encourage all whānau to support their kuia and koroua to pre-register, to contact our office if they have difficulties, and to connect to the AGM on Saturday 27 March. We also encourage whānau to watch the AGM with their kaumātua.

BEFORE YOU PRE-REGISTER

Pre-registration opens 8am on Saturday, 20 March 2021 and will close when the AGM starts at 10am on Saturday 27 March 2021. We strongly advise that you pre-register as early as possible so that you have time to sort any problems you might experience. **Please do not wait** until the day of the AGM to register.

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PRE-REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL SHAREHOLDERS

This page is for people who hold Tuaropaki Trust shares in their own name (Individual Shareholders) and your descendants.

Do I need anything to pre-register?

Yes, you will need the following things to pre-register:

1. A laptop or smartphone
2. Internet connection
3. Your shareholder number
4. Your full name:
 - Your full name must match the record held by the Māori Land Court when you succeeded to your shares or if you are a trustee when you were appointed.
 - If you have changed your name and you have provided us with a copy of the documentation that verifies your name has been legally changed then you will need to enter your new name.
5. Verification of your date of birth:
 - If we do not have your date of birth you will need to provide verification of your date of birth by uploading a copy of your driver's licence or passport.
6. An email address
7. A password

If you do not have any or all of the above, you will be **unable** to pre-register and therefore you will not be able to access the online AGM.

How do I pre-register?

Step One:

There are two ways to access the AGM website to pre-register:

1. Type this address into your web browser, www.livenz.tv/tuaropakiagm; or
2. Go to the Trust's website www.tuaropaki.com and click the link to the AGM website.

Step Two:

3. The AGM website home page will have two buttons. Click on the button that says, **"Registration"**.
4. Check the **"Shareholder"** box.
5. Enter your shareholder number.
6. Confirm you are the Shareholder by checking the **"Yes"** button.
7. Complete the registration process by completing all fields.
8. When you have finished entering your information click on the button that says, **"Complete Registration"**.
9. You will be sent a confirmation email. When you receive it click on the confirmation button. If you do not receive it within 5 minutes, please check your SPAM folder or your Junk folder as it may have gone to one of these.

10. Once you have confirmed your email you are registered to log onto the online AGM. **Keep your email and password in a safe place.** If you lose or forget either your password or email or both, you will **not** be able to log onto the online AGM.

How will I know if there is a problem with my pre-registration?

When you are completing the pre-registration process you will know immediately if there is a problem because you will be unable to complete the pre-registration process. Children, mokopuna, and whāngai of Individual Shareholders

We encourage whānau to watch the AGM together. However, if your children or mokopuna can't watch the AGM with you, then you can give them permission to watch the AGM (but they can't ask questions or vote).

How do my children, mokopuna and/or whāngai pre-register?

Step One:

Access the AGM website to pre-register:

1. Type this address into your web browser, www.livenz.tv/tuaropakiagm; or
2. Go to the Trust's website, www.tuaropaki.com and click the link to the AGM website.

Step Two:

3. The AGM website home page will have two buttons. Click on the button that says, **"Registration"**.
4. Click on the **"Descendant"** box.
5. Enter the Individual Shareholders' shareholder number.
6. Complete the registration process by completing all fields.
7. When you have finished entering your information click on the button that says, **"Complete Registration"**.
8. You will be sent a confirmation email. When you receive it click on the confirmation button. If you do not receive it within 5 minutes, please check your SPAM folder or your Junk folder as it may have gone to one of these folders.
9. Once you have confirmed your email you are registered to log onto the online AGM. **Keep your email and password in a safe place.** If you lose or forget either your password or email or both, you will **not** be able to log onto the online AGM.

Descendants of shareholders who have pre-registered, you will be able to view the AGM only (you cannot vote or ask questions).

ON THE DAY OF THE AGM

On the day of the AGM, log into the AGM website home page again:

Step One:

- Type this address into your web browser, www.livenz.tv/tuaropakiagm; or
- Go to the Trust's website, www.tuaropaki.com and click the link to the AGM website.

Step Two:

- On the Home page click the, “**Livestream Log In**” button.
- Enter your email and password that you pre-registered with then click the Log In button. You will be taken to the live stream page.
- If you do not enter the same email and password that you pre-registered with you will **not** be able to access the online AGM.

Step Three:

Once you have entered your **email address and password** you will be taken to the **AGM livestream page**.

Shareholders will be able to:

- View the AGM; and
- Move and second motions; and
- Vote; and
- Ask questions.

Descendants of shareholders will be able to view the AGM.

How to ask questions

As usual, individual shareholders have the ability to ask questions. Once you have successfully pre-registered, the system will automatically recognise that you have the right to ask questions. On the day of the AGM, when you log into the AGM you will see the live stream of the AGM on the left of your screen, and a chat box on the right of the screen. All questions must be typed into the chat box.

All questions will be received by a moderator who will pass them to the trustees. Questions will be addressed in General Business (as per normal meeting process).

How to move, second and vote on resolutions

As much as possible, we are following our normal meeting process. That means:

- A resolution will need to be moved by an Owner, and seconded by another Owner.
- To move a resolution, type the word “**Move**” and then click the send button.
- To second a motion, type the word “**Second**” and then click the send button.
- Once moved and seconded, the Chair will put the motion to a vote. Check the “**Yes**” button to agree and then click the send button **or** check the “**No**” button if you disagree and then click the send button.

Once the votes have been received the Chair will announce whether the motion has been carried or not.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What do I do if I don't know my full registered name with the Trust?

2. What do I do if I can't remember my shareholder number?

3. Can I log onto more than one electronic device?

No, you cannot log onto more than one electronic device at the same time.

4. What does having full access to the online AGM mean?

If you are an individual shareholder and you successfully complete your pre-registration, you will be able to view the AGM online, vote, and ask questions.

5. Can I access the online AGM if I am not a shareholder?

If you are not a descendant of a shareholder or a member of a whānau trust, then you will not be able to view the online AGM.

6. My kuia is the shareholder but she doesn't know how to use a computer, can I log onto the AGM for her instead?

Whānau are encouraged to support their kuia and koroua to connect to the online AGM. You can do this by:

- Helping your kuia or koroua to pre-register,
- Helping them to contact us on 07 376 2500 if they have difficulties,
- Helping your kuia or koroua to connect to the AGM on Saturday 27 March (and watching the AGM with them).

Due to privacy considerations our team cannot discuss your kuia or koroua personal information without their permission, so if you call us, then please make sure they are with you when you make the call.

7. Can I get help with pre-registration?

Yes. We are developing a range of support options including online videos showing you how to pre-register, or you can call us on 07 376 2500. We also encourage you to check our website, www.tuaropaki.com regularly for updates on the pre-registration process.

8. Can I ask questions during the online AGM?

Individual shareholders and trustees of whānau trusts can ask questions.

Descendants of individual owners and members of whānau trusts can watch the AGM but cannot ask questions.

9. When will my questions be answered?

This will be managed in the same way as our ordinary kanohi ki te kanohi AGM. In other words, questions can be asked (and answered) after the presentations and during General Business.
