### **CONFIRMED CHANGE OF VENUE – MŌKAI / TAUPŌ WĀNANGA**

We are also preparing for the final wānanga in this series, being Mōkai/Taupō. Our original intention was to return to Mōkai, and particularly to our wharenui, Pakaketaiari. However, owing to the significant number of whānau who have sent us their RSVP, we are unable to host the large numbers at Mōkai Marae. We have now changed our venue to host more whānau and uri.
